4.0 What to Bring/Not to Bring

4.1 What to Bring

- Toiletries (toothbrush and paste, comb, washcloth, deodorant, etc.)
- Change of clothes and PJ's—These must all be appropriate. If you are unsure, ask a leader.
- Bible, pen, paper
- Sleeping bag or blankets (yes, you must have this—parents please check)
- Any snacks you want to bring
- Some money for Saturday dinner (or a sack lunch) and anything you want to buy

4.2 What Not to Bring

- You won't need any books that aren't the Bible. You won't have time to read them anyway. Don't bring these at all.
- No illegal or banned items (knives, weapons, drugs, alcohol, etc)
- No cell phones or iPod / iPhone / iAnything. They will only be a distraction. All leaders will have cell phones in case of emergencies. This is not negotiable. Students with these will be sent home. Parents will have the leaders' cell phones in case of emergency.

2.1 Who?

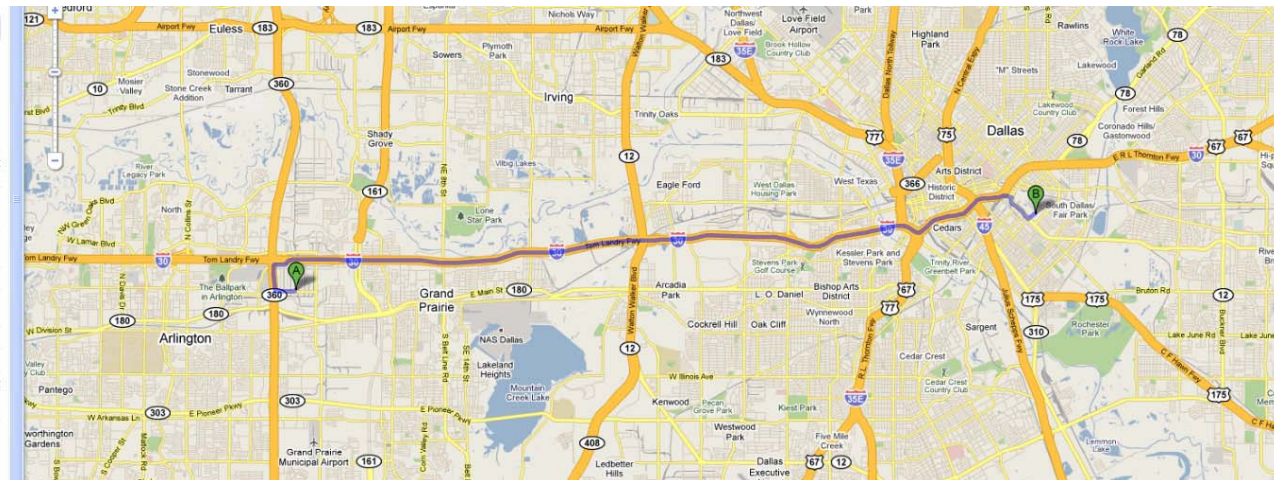

8. Turn left at Pennsylvania Ave 0.2 mi
9. Turn right at the 3rd cross street onto 1st Ave 11.2 mi
